ただいまから、放送を聞いて答える問題を始めます。問題は、1番～4番まであります。それぞれの問題の英文や英語の質問は2度放送されます。

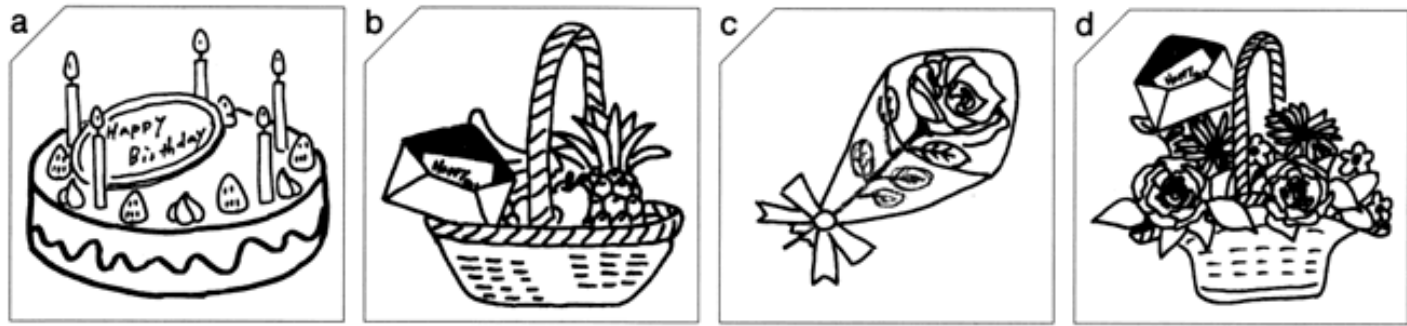
Last Sunday, I went to the city library and I saw some students studying there. Which do you like better, studying at a library or studying at your house? And why?

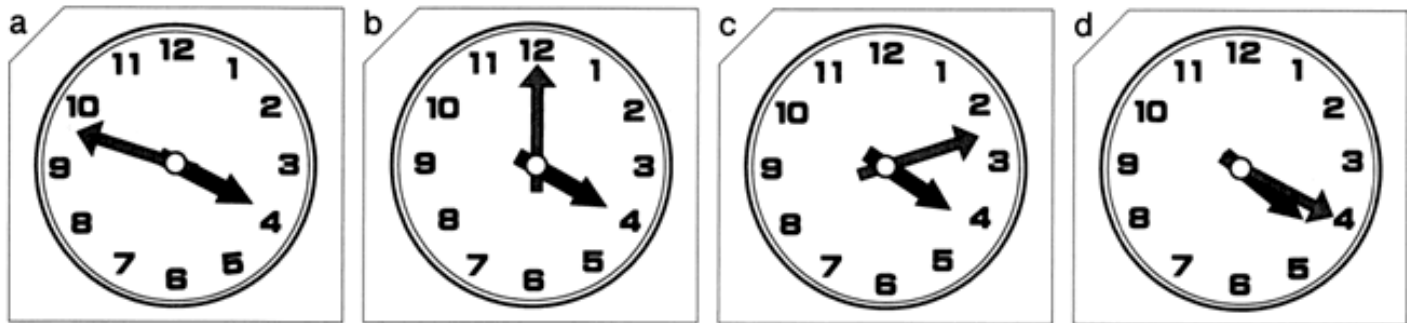

8 次の英文は、Keikoのスピーチです。これを読んで、後の(1)~(4)の問いに答えなさい。

Have you ever thought about working? I have not \*decided my \*future job yet, but I started to think about jobs during my school's work \*experience days last month. I was interested in \*care workers helping \*elderly people, so I worked at a \*nursing home near my house with Satoshi, one of my friends. We worked there for five days.

Before the work experience, Ms. Ikeda, our teacher, said to our class, "You will start the work experience next Monday. This is a new experience for you.  A  If you don't know what to do, please ask someone around you." After the class, I said to Satoshi, "Next week will be exciting. Let's try our best!"

On the first day of the work experience, Mr. Nakano, one of the care workers, told us about our work at the nursing home. He said, "Keiko and Satoshi, the most important thing here is \*communication with people around you. Please remember that." In the morning, I talked to an elderly woman, Ms. Yoshida. I told her many things about me, but she didn't talk very much. At lunch Satoshi said to me, "Is everything OK, Keiko?" I said, "Well, communication was not easy for me. I want to talk with Ms. Yoshida more, but I don't know how to do it." Satoshi said, "Let's ask Mr. Nakano \*later." \*At the end of the day, I went to Mr. Nakano with Satoshi and asked him. Mr. Nakano said, "Keiko, why don't you watch the care workers talking to the elderly people?"

Next morning I watched the care workers \*carefully and \*noticed an important thing. After that, I talked to Ms. Yoshida again. This time I looked at her eyes and listened to her more carefully. Then she talked more to me. She said, "Thank you very much, Keiko. You listened to me \*kindly today. Let's talk again tomorrow." During the next three days I enjoyed talking with her and some other people. On the last day, Mr. Nakano said to me, "Thank you very much.  B  Did you have a good time?" I said, "Yes. I'm happy because I enjoyed talking with the elderly people." Mr. Nakano said, "I think that's one of your \*good points."

When we were going home, Satoshi said, "I was glad to see the happy faces of the elderly people. Now I've learned it's important to make other people happy through my job in the future." I \*agreed with him. I think we should use our own good points when we do our job. What do you think about it?
